Weekly Highlights

- Buyer activity saw an uptick. Home buying activity saw an uptick for the second week in a row. New pending sales rose 3.8% from last week. With rates ticking lower during the week, some purchaser same back to the market. Howveer, weekly new purchase activity is still more than 15% lower than it was three years apo
- Homes are on the market a week longer than last year. Days on market for the week rose to 22 days, which was a week longer than last year and was up 5 days compared to last week. As homes stay on the market longer, inventory is higher than a year ago. Average daily inventory for the week was 30.5% higher than a year ago, offering buyers in the market more options.




